Advisor Children

Aim: To create road safety for children (helmet projects/seat belts/safe bicycles)

Advisor Traffic Parent

Aim: To recruit and support Traffic parents

Advisor Youngsters

Aim: To get youngsters involved in road safety matters (driving license moped/alcohol)

Advisor Senior

Aim: To give lecture, test or inform the target group to stay mobile in a safe way as long as possible

Advisor Businesses

Aim: Getting businesses involved in safe mobility programs

Advisor Driving under influence

Aim: To reduce driving under influence of alcohol or drugs

Advisor Safe residential area

Aim: To realize citizen involvement; to measure speed of car drivers and motorcyclists

Coordinator promotion team

Aim: To inform individual civilians during actions about all kind of road safety issues

Media & Public relations

Aim: Generate spin off for actions and building up a relationship with journalists

Sponsoring

Aim: Trying to get complementary funds for concrete actions

Association

Aim: To coordinate activities in general
